# HACHETTE UK DISTRIBUTION

Hachette UK is undertaking a major initiative to consolidate its distribution operations into a new, world-class distribution centre. We are calling this Project Eden. The project was announced in July 2016 and it will be concluded mid 2020.

The distribution centre will be a new trading entity called Hachette UK Distribution, located near the existing Bookpoint warehouse (at Milton Road, Didcot, Oxfordshire, OX11 7HH). The Bookpoint site will be retained for bulk storage but Hachette's LBS warehouse will close in 2019.

In mid 2018, the first publishing division, Octopus Publishing Group, will move to the new distribution centre. This will be followed by the phased transition of the other publishing divisions currently distributed by LBS. Publishers distributed by Bookpoint will begin to move to the new site in 2019.

The distribution centre, which will be fully automated, will include: A new order to Cash System (SAP) A new Warehouse Management System (JDA)
